JCD, BCL observe strike at BUET

No classes were held at the Bangladesh University of Engineering and Technology yesterday due to a strike called by both the Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) and Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD).

The strike was called after activists of the two organisations had an altercation. The JCD activists reportedly attacked and ransacked the room of Mainul Hassan, the GS of Ahsanullah Hall, Chhatra Sangsad, on Wednesday. Later that day, while the JCD workers were holding an interval meeting in the guest room of Titumir Hall, the BCL activists ransacked the place and clashed with the rival activists. Both

JCD and BCL brought out protest processions after this incident late Wednesday night.

The Chhatra Dal later called a student strike. Leaders of both BCL and JCD then sat down together to resolve the situation. BCL asked JCD to withdraw the strike but JCD did not respond positively. Then the BCL also called a strike.

The main gate of BUET was obstructed by both BCL and JCD yesterday morning. No further violence was reported till the writing of this report.
