BCL boycotts DU Environment Council meet

The meeting of Paribesh Parishad of Dhaka University was adjourned as the ruling party backed Chhatra League boycotted the meeting on Monday, reports UNB.

The university authorities convened the meeting to review the present campus situation, particularly the terrorist acts.

But the BCL leaders left the meeting protesting what they said the presence of Partha's killer at the meeting.

Partha, a BCL leader, was killed in a clash between the activists of JCD and BCL on April 23.

The JCD leaders at the meeting urged the university authorities to arrest the outsiders from its dormitories in order to restore academic atmosphere on the campus.

The GCO leaders called for immediate disclosure of the list of campus terrors and action against them.

Presided over by Vice Chancellor Prof. AK. Azad Chowdhury, the meeting also discussed the proposed amendments to the DUCSU constitution.

It was attended, among others, by the DU Proctor, hall Provosts and the representatives from BNP's student front Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal and Ganotantric Chhatra Oikya.
