## DUCSU leaders call to resist alien, culture

DUCSU leaders have urged the people to resist what they said the aggression of alien culture in the country; reports UNB.

DUCSU VP Aman Ullah MP and GS Khairul Kabir Khokon in a joint statement on Sunday expressed concern over the recent performance of indecent dance and songs by some Indian artists in Dhaka.

They said with the direct collaboration of the government, these performers held programmes during the month of February when the nation commemorated the martyrs of language movement.

"It is a serious blow to our social values and an attack on our culture and tradition" said the statement.

The DUCSU leaders also expressed their concern over the price hike of essentials, chaotic situation prevailing in the administration and failure of the government to run the country.

They termed the incident at the central Shaheed Minar on Ekushey as an stage-managed drama of the government.
