ICMA students urge authority to accept their 20-point demand

Students of ICMA staged demonstration at the institute premises at Nilkhet for the eighth consecutive day on Tuesday demanding immediate implementation of their 20-point demand.

The demands include curtailment of the additional admission fee, withdrawal of the decision of adding extra ten per cent examination fee every year and computer lab and other facilities.

The students brought out a procession and held brief rally at the institute premises on Tuesday. The rally was addressed, among others, by Bakhtiar and Kudu.

They complained that the authorities had increased the admission fee from Taka 2500 to Taka 5500 and ten per cent extra examination fee. They also alleged that general students were not allowed to use the computer lab although computer education is essential for ICMA students.

They urged the authorities to accept the demands immediately. Otherwise, they warned of launching a greater movement.

As part of the ongoing programme, the students will arrange a procession and rally at the institute premises today (Wednesday).
