JCD brings out procession on DU campus

Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD), the student front of opposition BNP on Monday brought out a procession on the Dhaka University campus after a lull of one month, reports UNB.

The JCD activists were ousted from the campus after a clash with pro-Awami League Chhatra League on April 23 that left a BCL leader killed.

Later, the Dhaka University Syndicate had imposed a ban on holding processions and rallies on the campus from May 7 to May 24.

After Monday's procession, the JCD activists held a rally in front of the Arts Faculty main gate.

Addressing the rally, the leaders demanded immediate arrest of the outsiders who have been staying at the university dormitories disrupting normal academic atmosphere on the campus.

They alleged that the "armed cadres" of Chhatra League are roaming around the campus under the nose of the law-enforcing agencies.

Among others, JCD acting president Abdul Khaleq, general secretary Habib-un-Nabi Sohel, ABM Mosharraf Hossain, Monwar Hossain Rana and Munir Hossain addressed the rally.
