## Rangamati College closed *sine die*: 10 hurt in clashes

CHITTAGONG, Mar 16: At least 10 people were injured in sporadic clashes between two rival student groups at Rangamati College and at its surrounding areas today.

Of them, a tribal and a non-tribal student were admitted into the Rangamati Hospital with serious wounds.

According to police and local sources, the clash broke out on the college campus following an altercation between a tribal and a non-tribal student over cardplaying and smoking at around 1 pm.

The clash soon spread outside the campus as tribal and non-tribal students were locked in a series of clashes till 5 pm using lethal weapons and brickbats.

Police rushed to the spot and lobbed tear gas shells and resorted to lathicharge to disperse the clashing groups.
