Rangpur Medical College closed sine die

RANGPUR, Dec 27.—The authorities today closed Rangpur Medical College (RMC) for an indefinite period of following destructive activities by a number of students on the college campus.

Students have been asked to vacate their dormitories within 24 hours.

Sources said, a group of students who failed in different examinations turned violent and damaged three private cars of doctors and furniture of the administrative building of the college worth about Taka five lakh. The Vice-President (VP) of the College Students' Union Chowdhury Mohammad Anwar allegedly led the agitation.

The RMC unit of Bangladesh Medical Association decided to lodge a case against the VP and other students involved in the incident, sources said.
