Chairmen of five S S C and H.S C. Education Boards of Dhaka. Chittagong, Comilla Rajshahi and Jessore submitted the results of SS C examination, held this year, to President Justice Shahabuddin Ahmed at Bangladesh on Tuesday, reports BSS.

The Chairmen of the boards pointed out to the President various problems of sitting arrangements and conducting various nation-wide examinations. They are of opinion that if the examinations are held in one centre only at the thana headquarters, it would be well-organised; and conducted peacefully reducing the chance of adopting unfair means in the examination.

Chairmen of five boards submitted the results of SSC examination, held this year, to Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina at her office in Dhaka on Tuesday.

The Prime Minister stressed the need for reintroducing academic inspections of the various schools and the training of teachers at every leavel. She also urged them to reduce the annual vacations of the school allowing more time for learning.

The Board Chairmen pointed out that the duration of examination be shortened from three weeks to two weeks. Education Secretary Kazi Raquibuddin Ahmed and Principal Secretary to the Prime Minister Dr S.A Samad were present.
