The results of Degree (pass) and certificate course examinations of 1997 held under the National University (NU) were announced on Sunday.

A total of 2,16,943 examinees from about 900 colleges across the country sat for the examinations. Of the total 65,434 came out successful. The percentage of Degree pass is 34.65.

Out of the total 2,16,943 candidates—1,58,284 were male and the rest 58,659 female.

Of the total 65,434 successful candidates, 226 secured first class, 34,373 second class and 30,844 obtained third class.

A total of 1,12,325 examinees appeared in the BA (pass) examination of them 15,641 came out successful. The number of examinees sat for the BSS examination were 53,261, of whom 15,641 passed. A total of 16,061 candidates appeared in the examination of BSc (pass), of them 5653 came out successful and in BCom (pass) some 31,323 examinees appeared, of them 11,103 came out successful. The pass percentages of BA, BSS BSc and BCom are 32.45, 32.74, 41.20 and 41.10 respectively.

Md Noman Hasan of Sirajganj Government College (Roll No P-14690) topped merit list of BA (pass) obtaining 659 marks with distinction in Islamic studies. Md Golam Kibria of Dhaka College bearing Roll No P-72399 secured second position obtaining 685 marks with a letter in Islamic studies. Kiran Japmala Crush of Mohammadpur Women College, Dhaka bearing Roll No 72581 stood third with a total marks of 680.

In BSS (pass) group Abu Siddique Md Saifuddin Mahmood Bhuiyan of Chowmohini SA College, Noakhali bearing Roll No 164893 stood first obtaining 620 marks. Md Kamruzzaman of Cantonment College, Jessore (Roll No 168397) secured second position obtaining 616 marks. Nurunnahar of Abujar Giffari College, Dhaka (Roll No P-150468) got third position with 611 marks.

In BCom (pass) group Mohammad Sazzad l-lossain of Government Titumir College, Dhaka (P-187234) and Md Shamim Iqbal of Government Haji Mohammad Mohsin College, Chittagong (P-196258) jointly secured the first position obtaining 633 marks. Md Khairul Islam Talukder of Ideal College, Dhaka (Roll No 187309) got second position with 621 marks while Md Saimur Rahman of Dhaka City College (Roll No 183787) stood third securing 617 marks.

In BSc (pass) group Luthfun Nahar of Ispahani Degree College, Dhaka (Roll No 212005) and Sharif Mohammad Kamrul Hasan of Government Shaheed Suhrawardy College, Dhaka (Roll No 213583) jointly stood first obtaining 690 marks. Lipika Rani Shaha of Matlab Degree See Page 12 Col. 2

In group of Bachelor of Music (B Music) a total of 30 students appeared, of them 4 came out successful. All of them got second division. Pass percentage of this group is 26.67.

In the certificate course examinations, 3943 students appeared, of them 1360 came out successful. The percentage of pass in this group is 49.54.
