The results of the Higher Secondary Certificate (HSC) examinations held under five education boards of the country in May this year were published simultaneously on Thursday. The average pass percentage was 53.40.

A total of 5,44,291 examinees appeared in the examinations under Dhaka, Rajshahi, Jessore, Comilla and Chittagong boards. Of them, 2,90,627 came out successful. Of the successful examinees, 68,674 got first division, 1,79,954-second division and 29,115 students secured third division while 12,882 examinees were given special pass. Out of the total appeared examinees, - 1 3,39,897 were male students while 2,04,394 were female. The number of successful male and female students was 1,75,179 1,15,448 respectively.

One lakh 66 thousand 572 students sat for the examinations from Dhaka Board. Of them 86,955 came out successful. Of the successful examinees 24,257 got first division, 49,504 second division and 8,726 obtained third division. The number of special pass from this board was 4,468. The percentage of pass in Dhaka Board was 52.20. In Dhaka Board Haque (roll Abedul Md. no.104036) of Dhaka College and Kazi Mohammad Shamim-Al-Mamun (roll no.105566) of Notre Dame College jointly topped the combined merit list from Science, Agricultural Science and Home. Economics groups.

The number of students appeared in the examinations from Rajshahi Board was 1,46,954.Of , them, 90,953 came out successful. Out of the total successful stu dents 20,533 secured first division, 57,694-second division and 8,990 third division while 3736 students were given special pass. The percentage of pass in this board was 61.89. Md. Bahalul Haider bearing roll no. 114917 of Rangpur Cadet Collège secured the first position in the combined merit list of Science, Agricultural Science and Home Economics groups: He got 962 marks with distinction in four subjects.

nees 41,817 came out successful from Jessore Board. Of the successful students 11,963 obtained first division, 24,689-second division and 3165 third division. The number of special pass was 2,000. The percentage of pass in the board was 42.73. Abdullah Al Reza (roll no. 202519) of Barisal Cadet College topped the combined merit list of Science, Agri. Science and Home Economics groups in Jessore Board with 971 marks and letters

in four subjects.

A total of 88,213 students appeared in the examinations from Comilla Board. Of them 40,102 came out successful. Of the successful examinees 7,107 got first division, 26,530-second division and 4,428 third division while 2,037 students were given special pass in this board. The percentage of pass in the Comilla Board was 45.46. In/Comilla Board, Maliha Sultana (roll no. 100519) of Sylhet MC College stood first in the combined merit list of Science,

Agri. Science and Home Economics groups. She secured 929. marks with distinctions in four subjects.

The number of students sat for the examinations from Chittagong Board was 44,685. Of them. 30.800 succeeded. Out of the total successful examinees, 4,814 students obtained first division, 21, 537 second division and 3,808 third division. Only 641 students were given special pass in this board. The percentage of pass in ! this board was 68.93. Mohammad Afzal Hossain (roll. No.100847) Of Chittagong College topped the combined merit list of Science, Agri. Science and Home Economics groups from Chittagong Board securing 901 marks. He obtained letter marks in four sub-Q jects.
