

Dakhil exam results announced

Results of the Dakhil examinations of 1999 held under the Bangladesh Madrasah Education Board, Dhaka, were announced on Saturday, reports BSS.

A total of 1,35,974 students sat for the examinations and of them 97,814 came out successful. The pass percentage is 71.94.

Among the successful examinees, 26,735 got First Division, 63,714 Second Division and 7,365 Third Division.

The pass percentage is higher to the female students (73.47) than the males (71.20).

32,507 female examinees out of 44,245 passed in the examinations while 65,307 male examinees out of 90,138 became successful.

The 79.41 pass percentage in the Science Group was the highest in the results followed by 71.17 in the General Group 68.98 in the Muzabbid Group and 50 in the Hifzul Quran.

In the Science Group 5,599
got First Division, 4,377 Second
Division and 188 Third Division, in the General Group
21,046 secured First Division,
59,167 Second Division and
7,170 Third Division, in the
Muzabbid Group, 87 examinees
got First Division, 164 Second
Division and 7 Third Division
and in the Hifzul Quran Group 3
students secured First Division
and 6 Second Division.

Muhammad Nasir Uddin Laskar of Dhampti Islamia Kamil Madrasah topped the combined merit list securing 901 marks with distinctions in eight subjects.

Muhammad Nazmul Hasan of the same Madrasah became second in the combined merit list securing 881 marks with six disfunctions and Mohibullah of

Narayonpur DS Fazil Madrasah secured third position in the combined merit list with 880 marks and distinctions in seven subjects.

Muhammad Nasir Uddin, Muhammad Nazmul Hasan and Mohibullah also secured first, second and third positions respectively in the combined merit list for the Science Group.

In the combined merit list for female students, Submul Zuhra, Kaniz Fatema and Nusrat Zahan of Mahmuda Khatun Mohila Fazil Madrasah secured first, second and third positions respectively.

Aminul Ehasan Al-Quaderi of Namazgar Gawsul Azam Kamil Madrasah, Md. Mahbubur Rahman of Tamirul Millat Kamil Madrasah and Md.
