

Pass percentage 35.70

Degree (Pass) exams results announced

The National University on Saturday announced the results of Degree (Pass) and certificate course examinations held in 1998, reports BSS.

The percentage of pass is 35.70.

A total of 1,84,326 appeared in BA (Pass), BSS (Pass), B Sc (Pass), B Com (Pass), B Music (Pass) and certificate course examinations. 65,812 came out successful. Of them 45,323 are male and 20,489 female.

The pass percentage of male and female are 34.23 and 39.46 respectively.

According to the results, 87,363 candidates appeared in the BA (Pass) examinations. Of whom 28,959 came out successful. The pass percentage is 33.15.

Of the successful candidates from BA (Pass), 130 got First Division, 19,242 Second Division and 9,587 Third Division.

In BSS (Pass) examinations a total of 48,893 candidates appeared, of them 16,807 came out successful. The pass percentage of this group is 34.38.

Of the successful candidates, eight students obtained First Division, 10,069 Second Division and

6,730 Third Division.

In B Sc (Pass) examinations 15,856 candidates appeared, of them 6,457 came out successful. The pass percentage is 40.72.

Of the successful candidates, 177 obtained First Division, 5,050 Second Division and 1,230 Third Division.

A total of 29,242 candidates appeared in the examinations from the B Com Group. Out of the examinees, 12,392 came out successful. The pass percentage is 42.38.

Among the successful candidates, ten students got First Division, 5,383 Second Division and 6,999 Third Division.

The total students appeared in the B Music examinations were 21, of them only six students passed. The pass percentage of the music group is 28.57.

Among the B Music students, no one got First Class, only six secured Second Division and no one got the Third Division.

A total of 2,951 appeared in the certificate course examinations and 1,191 came out successful. The percentage of pass is 40.36.

Mohammad Maksudur Rahman of Government City College of Chittagong topped the combined merit list. Monoara Begum of Hathazari College became second while Mossammat Sabana Begum of Mirpur Girls Ideal College, Dhaka, secured the third position in the combined merit order of National University.

Mohammad Maksudur Rahman of Government City College of Chittagong securing 737 marks and two distinctions topped the merit list of Bachelor of Arts (Pass). Mossammat Sabana Begum of Mirpur Girls Ideal College, Dhaka, became second in the roll of honour in Arts Group securing 690 marks while Mohammad Nazmul Hussain of Narsingdi Government College became third obtaining 689 marks with two letters.

Monoara Begum of Hathazari College topped the merit order in the Bachelor of Science (Pass) securing 713 marks and one letter. Naorin Jahan of Nazirhat College of Chittagong became second in the list securing 681 marks and one letter while Mohammad Akbar Hossain of Swarupkathi College became third by obtaining 679 marks. In the merit order of Bachelor of Social Science (BSS-Pass) Salma Begum from Nangalcourt Hasan Memorial College topped the list securing 622 marks. Sahin Akter from Kazi Noman Ahmed College of Muradnagar became second by obtaining 617 marks and Mohammad Humayun Kabir of Nangalcourt Hasan Memorial College secured the third position by 612 marks.

In the Bachelor of Commerce Group Shofura Aktar of Mohammadpur Mahila College, Dhaka topped the merit list securing 641 marks.
