

HC directs RU to publish LL.B result

After 11-year-legal battle Mohiuddin gets his LLB (final) result from the High Court A Single Bench of the High Court Division on Sunday directed the Rajshahi University Authority to publish LLB. (final) result of Munshi Mohiuddin within two months. The court on the same judgement directed—the said University authority to pay all the cost of litigation to Mohiuddin.

Munshi Mohiuddin appeared at his LL.B. (Final) Examination under the Rajshahi University in 1987. He came out unsuccessful in the examination because, as claimed by the University, his Second Paper (CPC & Limitation Act) got crushed for short of one mark. Being confident about his performance he initiated a process of re-examination of his script. Subsequently it transpired, that University authority suspended both the examiners of the disputed paper on charges of malpractices adopted by them in respect of the said paper. But the University authority in violation of existing law published the result on the marking of one of the suspended examiners.

Mohiuddin challenged the result in a suit filed in a court of Munsif. The learned Munsif directed the University to produce in court the said script of the relevant paper. But University informed the court that all the scripts of the said paper were already sold out ! showing a date that elasped before the publication of result. In the wake of such an untoward situation the Learned Munsif gave his verdict directing the University authority to make an average of the marks obtained by the plaintiff in the rest six papers and assign the average marks on the disputed script and thereby publish his result accordingly. The University filed appeal challenging the Verdict of the Learned Munsif and 14 ultimately lost in it. Thereafter the University challenged the Verdicts of both the courts below the High Court and a Single Bench comprising Justice A.B.M. Khairul Haque passed the above direction to publish the result of Munshi Mohiuddin within two months.

It may be mentioned here that Mohiuddin having suffered the
