Poor degree result in Jamalpur colleges raises concern

JAMALPUR. Sept 13: The results of degree examinations in some colleges here have raised great concern.

The results of Government Asheq Mahmud College and Nandina College, two colleges in the sadar thana have frus-

In Nandina College 107 candidates appeared in the B A examination. But only two of them came out successful. Percentage of pass was ordy 1.86 per cent. One secured second division while another got third division.

A total of 1,724 students participated in the examination from Government Asheq Mahmud University College.

but only 36 students passed in the degree examination.

In the college a total of 204 students failed in the B.Sc.examination. In the Arts group 1,212 students appeared but only 22 students passed the examination. Only three came out successful out of 83 students in B Com examination, while 11 students passed in the certificate course examination from the college.
