

236 forged SSC mark sheets detected at Comilla Board

COMILLA, Apr 8.—Comilla Education Board detected forged SSC mark-sheets of 236 candidates waiting to sit for the upcoming Higher Secondary Certificate examinations from 76 colleges, reports UNB.

The Board authority in a drive as per the directive of the Education Ministry unearthed the forgeries and decided to take necessary actions, including cancellation of their registration. It already directed concern colleges principals to take action against them, board source said.

Preferring anonymity an official of the Board said most of the fake mark-sheets out of 10 districts under the Board were detected from the colleges in Sylhet district.

The Board authority also sent 10,000 Dhakhil passed mark-sheets of students who will be taking part in HSC exams from different colleges under the Board to Bangladesh Madrasha Education Board to justify their validity. "But as the Madrasha Board is yet to respond, Comilla Board authorities are in trouble," said the official.

991 false registration detected

UNB reports from Ctg: Some 991 students will not be able to appear in the HSC examination beginning April 27, as the Chittagong Education Board has not issued admit cards to them due to

registration problem.

The students from 31 colleges under the Board filled up their registration cards and submitted allegedly false documents in connivance with respective colleges. The Board has asked the colleges to submit original SSC mark sheet, registration cards and testimonial of the students but they failed.

Chairman of the Board Dr Enayetur Rahim told UNB that students who filled up their registration forms with the 'false' documents of 1994, 95 and 96 will not be allowed to sit in the examination. The Board issued show cause notice to the colleges for the irregularities, he added.

One held with forged mark-sheets

BSS reports adds: CID police arrested two persons from different areas of the Chittagong on Wednesday. One Mokammel Hossain (25) was arrested from Mehdiabag area on charge of possessing forged mark-sheets, certificates and testimonials of schools, colleges and the Chittagong University.

CID police also arrested Ridwan (22) from Nasirabad area and recovered two country made light guns and a dagger from his possession. Two separate cases were filed with Kotwali and Panchaish thana against the arrested persons.
