2727 more examinees expelled on 4th day

A total of 2727 examinees were expelled for cheating in different examination centres under Dhaka, Jessore, Rajshahi, Chittagong and Comilla education boards on the fourth day of HSC examinations yesterday.

The candidates sat for test on Bengali 2nd paper.

According Dhaka Education Board officials, a total of 451 examinees were expelled from different centres in 16 districts.

Of them, two were expelled in Dhaka city, 12 in Gazipur, five in Narayanganj, 21 in Narsingdi, nine in Munshiganj, six in Manikganj, 58 in Tangail, 69 in Mymensingh, 156 in Jamalpur, six in Sherpur, nine in Kishoreganj, 51 in Netrokona, 11 in Faridpur, eight in Gopalganj, 22 in Madaripur and six in Shariatpur.

Jessore Education Board officials said, a total of 258 examinees were expelled from different centres in 15 districts.

Of them, 21 examinees were expelled in Patuakhali, three in Barguna, 21 in Pirojpur, 23 in Bhola, seven in Jhalakathi, 24 in Khulna, 13 in Bagerhat, seven in Satkhira, 51 in Kushitia, five in Chuadanga, 24 in Meherpur, 30 in Jessore, one in Narail, 23 in Jhenidah, and four in Magura. No report was available from Barisal district due to the disruption in telecommunication network.

Our Chittagong office re-

ports: A total of 77 candidates were expelled from different centres under the Chittagong Education Board for cheating of examination.

Of them, 53 were expelled in Chittagong district, 11 in Cox's Bazar, four in Rangamati and nine in Khagrachhari.

Our Rajshahi office writes: Some 1476 candidates and two teachers were expelled in different centres and one fake candidate was arrested from Shah Makhdum College centre.

District-wise breakup of expulsion: 98 examinees were expelled in Rajshahi, 78 students and one teacher were expelled in Chapainawabganj, 35 in Natoré, 25 in Naogaon, 40 in Pabna, 227 in Sirajganj, 37 in Bogra, 79 in Joypurhat, 119 students and one teacher in Rangpur, 149 in Gaibandha, 189 in Dinajpur, 96 in Kurigram, 33 in Nilphamari, 31 in Lalmonirhat, 141 in Thakurgaon and 99 in Panchagar.

Comilla Education Board officials said a total of 465 examinees were expelled from different centres in six districts.

Of them, 11 in Sunamganj, 24 in Luxmipur, 26 in Brahmanbaria, 31 in Feni, six in Habiganj and 367 in Comilla.

Meanwhile, two outsiders were arrested at Daudkandi College centre as they allegedly tried to snatch answer-scripts after the examination.
