3577 more expelled on second day of SSC exams

Roughly 3.577 students were expelled on the second day of the Secondary School Certificate examination under five education boards.

Roughly 2,022 examinees were expelled on the second day. in 12 districts under Rajshahi 🦠 Education Board.

One-hundred-and-fifty-nine students were expelled in Raishahi, one teacher and 145 students in Nawabganj, 54 in Natore, 147 in Pabna, 100 in Nilphamari, 180 in Gaibandha. 265 in Dinajpur, one teacher and 172 students in Thakurgaon, five teachers and 89 students in Panchagar, 100 in Naogaon, 207 in Ranjpur and 404 in Shirajgonj.

At least 15 people were injured at the Shajatpur High School centre during clashes between police and students.

The trouble erupted when a vigilance team expelled 110 examinees for copying exams.

No students were expelled in Kazipur thana, despite an alarming increase in copying.

Police said eight people, including Faruk, Jamal, Shariful. Tozammel Haq, Tota, Shahinur and Kabir, were arrested for their alleged involvement in supplying copies.

Thirty-one SSC examinees were expelled on the second day of examination in Magura for

cheating.

Some 7,670 students of the district sat for English 2nd paper examination in eight centres, board officials said. No incident occurred in the district.

A Jessore Board official said about 743 examinees were expelled in 11 districts for copy-, and Comilla education boards. . ing on the first day of examination.

About 300 students were exfrom different centres under its , pelled in under areas under the Chittagong Education Board.

Three students were expelled . The number of expelled students in two other hill districts were 44 and 11 respectively.

According to Comilla Education Board officials, 1,065 students and nine teachers were expelled in the first day of examination. One school employee was killed in an examination centre under the same education board.

According to our Gazipur correspondent, about 30 students were expelled from 19 examination centres in the district. A total of 11,210 students are taking part in the examina-a tion. No untoward incidents were reported in the district.

 About 104 examinees were expelled from centres under the Jessore board, according to our Jhenidah correspondent

More than 5,000 students were expelled on the first day. Six people including three students and one teacher were killed and about 35 were injured on the first day at an examination centre in Kalaroa thana in Satkhira district under Jessore board.

BSS adds: A total of 499 students were expelled for cheating on the second day of the SCC examinations in Comilla.

According to board sources. 261 students were expelled in Comilla, 70 in Luximpur, 78 in Feni and 90 in Brahmanbaria.
