



## 4083 SSC examinees expelled

A total of 4083 examinees were expelled during the Saturday's secondary School Certificate (SSC) examination held under five education boards of the country for adopting unfairmeans. Ten teachers were also expelled on Saturday for assisting examinees in adopting of unfairmeans.

Of the total expelled students the highest number of 1948 examinees were expelled from Rajshahi Board, 837 from Dhaka Board, 553 from Jessore Board, 424 from Comilla Board and 321 from Chittagong Board.

The teachers expelled were 5 from Dhaka Board, 4 from Rajshahi Board and one from Comilla Board.

Untoward incidents were also reported from different centres during the Mathematics examination on Saturday.

Police arrested four persons when they tried to supply copies by breaking Section 144 in Mirpur Examination centres under Kushtia district.

A clash between police and visitors also took place in an examination centre at Savar during the examination. The clash erupted as the visitors attacked the Centre after expulsion of 7 examinees of the centre.

Police fired a blank shot to disperse the angry mob.
