7777 more HSC examinees expelled

A total of 7777 examinees were expelled for cheating at examination in different centres under Dhaka, Rajshahi, Jessore, Comilla and Chittagong education boards on the second day of HSC examinations yesterday.

They sat for test on English 2nd paper.

According to Dhaka Education Board officials, a total of 2039 examinees were expelled on the second day from different centres in 17 districts.

Of them, fifteen were expelled in Dhaka city, 57 in Gazipur, 34 in Narayanganj, 217 in Narsingdi, 36 in Munshiganj, 51 in Manikganj, 397 in Tangail, 362 in Mymensingh, 193 in Jamalpur, 215 in Sherpur, 48 in Kishoreganj, 65 in Netrokona, 67 in Faridpur, 74 in Gopalganj, 55 in Rajbari, 109 in Madaripur and 44 in Shariatpur districts.

Meanwhile, one vehicle carrying Thana Nirbahi Officer (TNO) was ransacked yesterday at Damudya in Shariatpur. The incident took place because of the strict measures taken by the local administration to check unfair means at examination centre.

In Rajbari, some expelled candidates ransacked the Government Adarsha Women College and injured at least seven people on the second day of examination.

According to official sources the expelled students and their friends attacked the college principal and some other employees at about 1 pm.

Four policemen were also injured during the incident. One of the injured employees of the college was admitted to Sadar Hospital. His condition was stated to be critical.

Our Jamalpur Correspondent reports: One person was sentenced to two years imprisonment supplying copy during English 2nd paper examination at a centre at Sarishabari yesterday.

Police said Ashraf Ali, son of Solimuddin of Patddeha village, was caught red handed while supplying copies to his friend at Reazuddin Talukder College centre. The on-duty magistrate formed a temporary court where Ali was found guilty and awarded the punishment.

Jessore Education Board (JEB) officials said a total of 1705 examinees and three teachers were expelled yesterday from different centres in 16

districts.

Police arrested 16 examinees and outsiders from three college centres in Kushtia for violating Section 144 imposed in and around the centres.

Of them, 99 candidates were expelled in Patuakhali, 33 in Barguna, 183 in Barisal, 81 in Pirojpur, 66 in Bhola, four in Jhalakathi, 152 in Khulna, 117 in Bagerhat, 90 in Satkhira, 338 in Kushtia, 79 in Chuadanga, 54 in Meherpur, 133 students and two teachers in Jessore, 45 in Narail, 202 in Jhenidah and 29 in Magura districts.

According to sources in Comilla Education Board, a total of 727 examinees were expelled from different examination centres under the board.

Our Correspondent from Rajshahi reports: Six vigilators and 3022 candidates were expelled yesterday from 15 districts for adopting unfair means, sources in Rajshahi Education Board said.

Of the total, two hundred seventy-five were expelled from Rajshahi, 197 students and three teachers in Chapainawabganj, 112 in Naogaon, 96 in Pabna, 284 in Rangpur, 279 candidates and two teachers in Gaibandha, one teacher and 197 students in Kurigram, 96 in Nilphamari, 49 in Lalmonirhat, 340 in Dinajpur, 201 in Thakurgaon, 128 in Panchagar, 521 in Sirajganj, 109 in Bogra and 138 in Natore.

Our Chittagong Correspondent writes: A total of 284 students were expelled yesterday for alleged cheating on the second day of HSC examination.

Of them, one hundred eighty-three were expelled in Chittagong city, 66 in Cox's Bazar, 22 in Rangamati, five in Bandarban and eight in Khagrachhari.

Meanwhile, some untoward incidents occurred at Govt Women College and Pahartali College centres where agitated copy suppliers and candidates ransacked windows and doors of the two colleges.
