HSC exam results tampering Chandgao police assigned to investigate case

CHITTAGONG, Oct 7:—The Chandgao police have taken up inquiry into the alleged case of betting scam of answer scripts and valuable documents relating to the cancellation of results of two top position holders in the HSC examination held under Chittagong Board in 1998.

Chandgao thana Sub Inspector Arshad Ali has been assigned to investigate the case and submit the report. "But the prima facie of the case gives the clear impression that it is a cognizable offence of serious nature and a case of daring theft of valuable government documents from the office," said

the Officer-in-Charge of Chandgao thana.

The Chittagong Board of Intermediate and Secondary Education in its board meeting on September 2 in a resolution conceded the fact of "missing of some of the documents" relating to the scam of HSC examination and suggested for instituting committee to inquire into the matter.

The same meeting gave concurrence to the recommendations of disciplinary committee to cancel the result of two top position holders—Syed Ashekul Kabir Mahmud and Syed Ruhuq

Chowdhury. The disciplinary committee meeting was presided over by the Chairman Prof. Ahmed Hossain took the decision for cancellation of results on August 30.

But the Chittagong Board surprisingly stayed silent about the grievous for long one month. The Board neither informed the police nor constituted the probe committee as per the decision of the Board Committee. After a long lapse, the Board Secretary Prof. Shahidullah lodged the General Diary with Chandgao thana in this connection.

A senior official of Chittagong Board when contacted said that the crisis in the board has now deepened and the board's reputation is now at lowest ebb.
