HSC candidates
to submit memo
to PM today

The guardians of 132 female HSC candidates of Motijheel Model School & College will submit a memorandum to the Prime Minister today (Sunday) to press for their demand, reports UNB.

In the memo, they will appeal to the Prime Minister so that their children are allowed to sit in the examinations although she already declared that they would not be allowed.

The guardians will start a procession towards the PM office at 9 a.m. from the college campus.

Dhaka Education Board blocked 132 female students from taking part in the examinations due to some faults in their registration forms regarding optional subjects.

The examinations are scheduled to begin on Thursday.
