Guardians of NHSC examinees protest police action on girls

Some guardians of the HSC examinees of Motijheel Model High School and College have announced a series of programmes to protest Thursday's police action on their wards and "lapses" of the college authorities, reports UNB.

The guardians told a press conference at the national Press Club on Friday that they will submit memoranda to the President, Prime Minister, Education Minister and Chairman of Dhaka Education Board on Sunday.

They have also decided to file two cases against the college authorities for the repression on the girl students and 'misappropriation of money taken from the girl students'.

Some injured students were present at the conference.

Police on Thursday morning resorted to lathicharge twice to disperse the agitating girl students of the college whose appearing in the ensuing Higher Secondary Certificate (HSC) examinations became uncertain due to, what they said, negligence and lapses of the management of the college.
