

## Teachers may boycott SSC duties

SIRAJGONJ, Feb 28:—Secondary school teachers will boycott Secondary School Certificate Examination scheduled to be held on March 2 if their demand to release B.L. Govt. school teacher Ashraf Ali Ansari was not met. Ashraf Ali Ansari was arrested in connection with a criminal case lodged by medical officer of Sadar Hospital Dr Sayad yesterday.

Family source of the detained teacher Ashraf Ali Ansari disclosed that Dr. Sayad was locked in fierce altercation with Ashraf Ali Ansari who wanted to know the cause of alteration of prescription for his child daughter at his chamber at Muktarpara. Dr. Sayad saw the child daughter of Ashraf Ali Ansari at morning of the same day at his official chamber at Sadar hospital and prescribed some tablets for the patient.

The teachers brought out a procession in the town and submitted a memorandum. They demanded immediate release of their colleague failing which they will boycott the ensuing SSC Examination.

When contacted the Secretary of BMA Dr. Akramuzzaman told me that Ashraf Ali Ansari man-handled Dr. Sayad at his chamber. The processionists ransacked the Community Hospital. A tense situation has been prevailing in the town.
