

## JCD calls strike at DU to protest PM's visit

Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD), the student wing of opposition BNP, has called for a strike at Dhaka University on Tuesday to protest Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina's visit to the campus on the day.

JCD general secretary Nasruddin Ahmed Pintu gave the call at a rally in front of the Aparajeya Bangla yesterday.

Sheikh Hasina is scheduled to visit the university on Tuesday to inaugurate Bangabandhu Chair in the Department of History.

"We are going to enforce the strike to protest Sheikh Hasina's arrival on the campus as her government continues repression on JCD men across the country and failure of DU authorities to take action against those responsible for attack on
