

JCD countrywide demonstration today

Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD), student wing of main opposition BNP, will submit memoranda to the Deputy Commissioners (DC) in different districts and stage demonstrations across the country today to press home its 12-point demand.

The demands include lowering prices of educational materials, prioritising the education sector in the national budget, introducing an education policy keeping pace with 21st century, constructing more residential halls, providing job opportunity for the students, and immediate release of all arrested JCD leaders and activists.

Meanwhile, in a statement Habib-Un-Nabi Sohel and Nasiruddin Ahmed Pintu, JCD president and general secretary respectively, demanded immediate release of four JCD leaders at Nilphamary including its Domar thana unit general secretary Abul Kalam Azad.
