

JCD to lead march towards PM's office Apr 25

Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal, the student wing of main opposition BNP, will lead a march towards Prime Minister's office on April 25 and hold a rally in the city soon as part of an action programme, says UNB.

JCD announced the programme in a Press briefing on Tuesday evening at the end of a two-day extended meeting that decided on the course of movement on its various demands.

Its demands include decrease in student fees and price of all educational equipment like books, pens and so, cuts in transport fare, arrest of the 'rapists' at Jahangirnagar University, release of JCD's jailed workers and leaders.

JCD President Habibunnabi Sohel read out a statement at the news conference where BNP Secretary General Abdul Mannan Bhuiyan, Amanullah Aman MP, Nasiruddin Ahmed
