The decision of the Medical Board will be final and no appeal will be enter tained. Admission will be made strictly according to merit and the income of the parents guardians will have no bearing for admission in the Cadet Colleges. > However, the fees that would have to be paid to the College by the parents guardians will depend entirely on the total income of the parents guardians of the candidate
