### Training Programme on Health Economics

The Institute of Health Economics, University of Dhaka, Dhaka, Bangladesh has arranged a month-long training programme on Health Economics. The major courses of this training programme are: Health Sector Management, Health Economics including Basic Economics, Economic Evaluation in Health Sector, Research Methodology in Health Sector Analysis and Application of Simple Computer Programs for Health Economic Research. The training programme will be held from April 24 to May 23, 1999 at the Institute of Health Economics, Arts Faculty Building, University of Dhaka. To facilitate the participation of inservice personnel classes will be organised in the evening from 5 to 8.30 PM everyday of the week. The number of participants will be limited to 30. The programme is sponsored by the DFID and as such no tuition fees will be charged. There is provision for a modest transport allowance. The course is specially designed for health sector administrators, policy-makers, and medical officers/practitioners. Preference will be given to the applicants working in the MOHFW, Directorate of Health, Directorate of Family Planning, NIPORT, medical college hospitals and NGOs providing health and family planning services and university teachers specialising in Health Economics.

Interested participants are requested to apply to Prof S R Howlader, Director, Institute of Health Economics, Arts Faculty Building, University of Dhaka by April 10, 1999. Applications should be made in a prescribed form obtainable from Mr Abdul Haque, System Analyst, Institute of Health Economics paying a fee of Taka 100/- (one hundred) only.
