Medical colleges become autonomous from July 1

Hospitals and medical colleges in the country will be brought under an autonomous administration, Deputy Prime Minister in charge of the Ministry of Health and Family Planning Prof M A Matin said in Dhaka yesterday, reports BSS.

He was speaking at the certificates awarding ceremony after a three-month course on hospital administration at

Nipsom auditorium at Mahakhali in the morning. Directorate of Health organised the course.

The DPM further said in the first phase all the medical colleges and 19 hospitals will function as autonomous institutions from July 1.
