The present age is modern age, age of computer. Computerisation system has already been successfully introduced in SSC & HSC examination of general education. Decision has been taken to introduce computerisation system for Dakhil, Alim, Fazil & Kamil examinations of Bangladesh Madrasa Education Board from 1999.

It is possible through coding to make examination results objective, fault free, maintain secrecy & publish in short time through computer. For this the work to take Dakhil, Alim, Fazil & Kamil examinations & process results is in progress.

Meanwhile ten teachers including centre secretary of all Madrasa examination centres throughout the country have been imparted training on rules & regulations of this system including filling in SIF of examinees in computer system, use of code number, tearing top portion of examination answer script & sending directly to computer centre in corrugated sheet box evaluation of bundled answer scripts by the examiner, giving marks by filling in the circle, tearing of middle portion by the head examiner & sending it to computer centre in corrugated box etc.

Under computer system, it would be possible to expedite filling of SIF by students, putting roll number to admit card, tabulation, issuing markesheet & certificate. Under this system, examination results will be preserved in database. If required this result can be displayed on line at college/university and if required, government can verify

any result quickly.

There being chances of complicities like various irregularities, duplicate registration etc. in existing registration system, Bangladesh Madrasa Education Board has decided to conduct name registration of students of Dakhil class IX, Alim, Fazil & Kamil first year (examinees for 2001) through RIF i.e. introduce computer system from 1999. As a result no registration of students in any class can be conducted after the prescribed date, under any circumstance in future.

Under the computerisation system, it will be possible to make name, registration of students, filling in examination application form, issue of admit card, putting roll number, preparation of result, issue of marksheet & certificate will be much faster & correct than in the existing system as well as it will cost less & thus save national resources.

Cooperation of all concerned including students, teachers, guardians, publicity media is solicited in this regard.
