Students set invigilation team car a fire

An investigation team from the Education Ministry came under attack at the Madrasha-e-Alia, Dhaka Centre on Monday morning when they were returning after recovery of huge quantity of written materials from the examinees of the Centre.

Some students set one private car of a senior government official on fire and assaulted its driver.

The team included the Deputy Secretary of the Education Ministry, Mr Tajul Islam Khan. The students attacked his car, damaged it and set it on fire. However, the Deputy Secretary was unhurt, police said.

The team members took shelter in the Principal's room. During the incident, one cocktail also exploded. One student was expelled from the centre on Monday for adopting unfair means in the examination.

Quoting the Deputy Secretary, Police said that over two gunny bags of written materials were recovered from the examinees during the invigilation.

One senior teacher of the madrasha was manhandled by a group of miscreants under disguise of students for detecting unfair means in the examination at the centre on Monday.

President of Islami Chhatra Shibir, Madrasha Unit Mr. A S M Abdul Fattah and Secretary Mr. Abdus Sattar in a joint statement condemned the attack on the teacher and demanded punishment to persons responsible for the incident.

Madrasha Chhatra Andolan Parishad in another statement condemned the attack on the teacher and demanded expulsion of those from the madrasha campus responsible for the attack.
