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need to be developed.

In order to develop teaching standard and research capabilities of our college teachers we need to send them according to areas of specialisation to various workshops, seminars and conferences at home and abroad. It is sad that people having no connection to educational institution and research are being sent abroad for attending them. It is a wastage.

Right methods of teaching enhances effective learning. But our traditional method of teaching in colleges is lecture which is not the right stimuli for all contents. Moreover, there is no system of supervision for the improvement of college education in Bangladesh. This state of affair needs to be changed.

Need to stop Private-tuition by the College Teachers:

Private-Tuition is a sort of private practice/business by the college teachers. Private-tuition by college teachers is dangerous both for college and the society. In so many countries, private tuition by the institutional teachers is prohibited by law. In fact, private-tuition is the job of the students of higher class, private people and coaching centres. We need a law and system for enforcement of law in this regard.

Standardization of Teacher-Qualification and College Facilities in the case of Nationalization:

The minimum qualifications required by the Public Service Commission for directly recruiting government college teachers is higher than that of private colleges. Thus nationalization of private colleges lowers the over-all qualification standard. Naturally, it is essential to take measures for raising the qualification standard of the teachers of the college which is

going to be nationalized, on the other hand, inadequacy in college facilities need to be met before nationalizing it otherwise the college will very much fail to impart education at par with other government colleges.

Measures for improving the standard:

For a nation, the need and importance of college education is immense. We must be very much careful in developing knowledge and skill through our college education system. To raise its standard we must tune it to our requirement by solving the problems standing on its way. The following are the measures for improvement.

First, we need to frame our long term objectives for college education. After that a Committee with higher education experts, educational psychologist, subject experts, college teachers and university representative should from the detail outline of college curriculum and college activities. Curriculum development and enrichment of college activities must be a continuous process.

Government needs to take up projects during the 5-year plan period to develop the physical facilities of colleges in phases. But each of the colleges should make effort to procure educational equipments too through their own regular budget or resources. In addition, the colleges can take loan of educational equipments from each other.

College students are the people of late-adolescent or early adulthood stage, society does not expect violence and indiscipline from them. More matured behaviour is expected of them. And money cannot be used to foster criminals in colleges. Colleges must be clear about these and the students must be informed about the code of student behaviour clearly. Law must be enacted to prohibit politics by college students and that must be enforced. On the other hand, like other colleges of the advanced world, there must be provision for enough creative club activities in college suitable to their development needs. To graduate from the college every student must at least be an active member of a club.
