Life sketches of new Ministers

Dr. Fasihuddin Mahtab and Dr M.A. Matin were State Ministers in the previous Government while Major-General (Retd) Nurui Islam, Khondkar Abdul Hamid, Abdur Rahman Biswas, Mr Emran Ali Sarkar, Mr. Abdul Haque, Mr. Monsur Ali and Mr. Moidul Islam were new-comers.

ABDUL HAQUE

The only son of late Alhaj Md Wazed Ali, Mr Muhammad Abember 15, 1926 at Ulashi in the district of Nadia.
