Mr. Abdur Rahman later 1010 ed the National Awami / Party founded by late Moulana Abdul Hamia Khan Bhashani and hela the offices of the Secretary and President of the Tangail. District NAP for a long period He became the Vice President of NAP in 1962 and held this office till the merger of NAP with the Bangladesh Nationalist Party in 1978.

Mr. Abdur Rahman was ap pointed a member of the Prest dent's Council of Ministers on June 29, 1978 and held the port tollo of Public Works and Urban Development. He was elected to the Jativa Sangsad in recent parliamentary elections from the constituency No. 138-Tangail-5. He was one of the top vote pollers in the election. A renowned social worker, Mr. Abdur Rahman is the foun der of several educational institutions and cutural and sectal welfare organisations.
