Again he joined the Dacca Universit, as Professor of Economics in July 1969. Later, he was Chairmar. Department of Economics Chairman, Bureau of Economic Research and Dean of the Faculty of Social Sciences Dacca University,

Dr. Huda was associated with several economic bodies of the then Pakislan from 1942 to 1962, ment of Pakistan and Panel of Economists for First and Seconomists cona Plans. He was elected President of the Pakistar: Econo mic Association in 1965.

Dr. Huda attended several national and traternational conference of ECAFE UNESCO. etc.

Obaidur Rahman

Mr. K.M. Obaidur Rahman was born in Faridpur in a respectable Muslim family on May 5, 1940. He obtained B. A. (Hons) and M.A. degrees from Dacca University."

Mr. Rahman started active politics from his student days. He was General "Secretary of the Dacca University Central Student Union in 1962-1963 and President, the then East Pake istan Students League im 1963

1965. He became Social Secretary of the Ithen East Pakistan Awami League vin 1966 and heid the post [till' 1971. He served as State Minister in the Ministry of Posts and Telegraphs from 1973 to 1975. He suffered political imprisonment for 6 years during Ayub regime.

Mr. Rahman joined the Council of Ministers in June, 1978 and was allocated the portfolio of the Ministry of Fisheries and Livestock: He was elected. Member of the Parliament from Faridpur-6 constituency during the 1979 parliamentary elections. He retained the , portfolio of the Ministry of Fisheries and Livestock when he was swornin as Minister on April 15, 1979*.*

terest in sports and gardening. a good orator took active part in the War of Liberation and freedom struggle.
