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Admission Problem

The University authorities have taken very stiff measures for admission of newly passed students to Honours Classes. For example, Jahangir Nagar University has decided to admit only 350 students to different faculties, whereas thousands of students have passed Intermediate Examination from the four Education Boards of the country.

Many students having good results are roaming from one University to another to get a seat. Similarly the other Universities have also decided to allow admission to only a few hundred students as against a few thousand passed students. The students who came out successful in the last year's Intermediate Examination are suffering from frustration, as they are not being allowed to prosecute higher studies. Our government is trying to increase the rate of literacy to 40% within the next couple of years. But what about higher studies? If students are denied high

er education according to their choice, this will ultimately result in the sheer wastage of a section of our educated manpower.
