JUCSU polls today

Elections to the Jahangirnagar University Central Students Union (JUCSU) and the hail e unions will be held today. Polling will be held between 9 a.m. and 3 p.m.

A total of 445 candidates are contesting for 94 posts of the central students union and the hall unions. Out of the total candidates, 129 contest for 16 seats of the central students union while 316 candidates for 73 posts of the six hall unions.

Prof Kazi Saleh Ahmed, vice-chancellor of the university, talking to newsmen yesterday evening, said the university authorities had taken all necessary measures for holding a peaceful election. He also thanked the students and the others concerned for their cooperation and hoped that they would continue this attitude to keep up a healthy atmosphere in the campus.

Chhatra Shibir—are the main
contestants in the elections.

Meanwhile, the university authorities impossed strict restriction on the outsiders' entry into the campus and advised the students to keep identity cards with them.
