

46.94 pc pass Dakhil exam

Results of Dakhil examination held under Madrasa Education Board this year were announced on Thursday.

A total of 21,865 students including 2,491 girls came out successful showing a rate of success at 46.94 per cent.

The results were announced by Alhaj Mansoor Ali Sarkar, Adviser to the President, at a

news conference at the Ministry of Education.

Education Secretary Mr. A. N. M. Yusuf and Chairman of Madrasa Education Board Md. Abdul Mannan were also present on the occasion.

A total of 46,584 students including 5,901 girls appeared at the examination from 193 centres this year.

The students from 4,098 Dakhil madrasas, all in non-government sector, appeared at the examination in four groups in Dakhil an equivalent level of secondary school certificate education.

Of the successful candidates, 890 boys and 60 girls were placed in first division. Tohfa Begum of Jessore Senior Madrasa stood first in combined merit list securing a total of 843 marks.

Rate of success in Dakhil general, science, mujabbid and hifjul quran groups are 46.98 per cent, 51.55 per cent, 35.33 per cent and 39.39 per cent respectively.

A total of 3,678 students were expelled from the examination this year for adopting unfair means.

According to Mr Mansur Ali Sarkar, government spent Taka 90 crore as teachers benefit and grants for madrasa education annually.
