Syllabus of kindergartens needs approval

All kindergartens and non-government schools of the country will have to get their 1989 syllabus and books approved by the government before including them in their curriculum, an official handout said in Dhaka on Wednesday, reports BSS.

These educational institutions will have to submit their proposed syllabus and books by September 30, 1988 for approval to the Special Committee set for the purpose and headed by the Chairman of the National Curriculum and Text Book Board, Text Book Bhaban, 68/70 Motijheel Commercial Area, Dhaka.

The handout said normally all the government schools and government aided educational institutions set their

curriculum according to the one approved by the Text Book Board, but the kindergartens and non-government schools sometimes follow curriculum not approved by the board, which could also give wrong impression to children about the country and its environment.
