Steps to solve CU problems mooted

CHITTAGONG, Oct. 25:—The Vice-Chancellor of Chittagong University yesterday held a meeting with the senior teachers, Deans of different faculties and departmental chairmen to discuss about the latest situation prevailing on the campus.

The Vice-Chancellor Prof. Mohammad Ali apprised his colleagues of the steps so far taken to resolve the crises after the strike of teachers. He sought the cooperation of every body to solve the problems of the university.

The senior teachers, however underscored the need for immediate settlement of the issues so that the students can pursue their studies unhindered.

The majority teachers of the Chittagong University are on strike since October 10 at the call of Chittagong University Teacher's Association. The teachers went on strike deman-

ding the expulsion of armed elements from the campus and harassment of the teachers by the hoodlums.

Appeal not heeded

The Teacher's Association did not pay heed to the recent appeal of Chittagong University Authority to call off the strike. The Association rather pledged to carry on the movement till the demands are fulfilled.

The Chittagong University Teachers Association through a press statement on Thursday said that the teachers would consider the resumption of duty only after the university authority takes measures to remove the terrorists from the campus.

A few teachers having allegiance to the Vice-Chancellor are found attending the classes.
