

Business management course for Ctg varsity teachers

CHITTAGONG: A three-week long seminar on Management and Education organised by the faculty of Commerce began in Chittagong University on August 13. The seminar is being participated in by 50 teachers of different affiliated colleges under Chittagong University. Vice-Chancellor of Chittagong University Prof. Alamgir Muhammad Serajuddin was the chief guest while Pro-Vice-Chancellor Prof. Ali Imdad Khan and the member of University Grants Commission Prof K A Latif were special guests.

While inaugurating the seminar the Vice-Chancellor of the University said that this would bring the college and university teachers closer and help build up understanding for the promotion of commerce education in the southern part of Bangladesh. He thanked the World Bank, ERD and other agencies for helping the project which has helped in improving the standard of education of commerce in the country.

He further said that the seminar would give a scope for mutual exchange of ideas and knowledge among college and univer-

sity teachers and thereby the real problems of commerce education could be identified for eventual resolution. The VC said that though the project's duration was over measures would be

taken so that this could go on with the help and co-operation of all concerned.

The Pro-Vice-Chancellor of the university Prof. Ali Imdad Khan in his speech said that the whole project should be evaluated. In this connection he also said that the impact of the seminar should be taken into consideration and it should be properly evaluated.

Prof. K A Latif in his address told the audience that the project under the aegis of the World Bank, ERD Planning Commission would bring fruitful results and hoped that it has achieved cent per cent success. This project according to him has improved the standard of business management education in the country. Prof. Latif further said that this project had been divided into three sectors teacher education, infrastructure and text book writing in Bengali.

Dr Zahurul Hoq, chairman of the department of Accounting, hoped that things would improve with the completion of the whole project of training teachers of Commerce. He called for the expansion of the Commerce Faculty of Chittagong University by opening departments of Marketing and Finance on a priority basis.

In his presidential address the Dean of the faculty of Commerce Mr Abdul Mannan expressed his gratitude to all for attending the seminar and he hoped that it would make a real breakthrough in Commerce Education in our country.
