



CU measure to ease session jam

CHITTAGONG, Nov. 16:—Prof Alamgir Muhammad Serajuddin, Vice-Chancellor of Chittagong University said that additional classes would be taken to cope with session jam problem of the students, reports BSS.

Speaking as the chief guest at a freshers' reception here Prof Serajuddin said that the decision to take extra classes was taken following recommendations by the four-member session jam cell appointed earlier by the university administration.

The Vice-Chancellor said that both the Education Ministry and the University Grants Commission assured necessary financial assistance and other logistic supports to arrange additional classes.

The session jam, the Vice-Chancellor said it had created anxiety among the guardians, teachers, students and the university administration.

Presided over by the Chairman of Public Administration Department Abdur Nur the function was also addressed, by Pro-Vice-Chancellor Ali Imdad Khan as special guest. The function was rounded off with a cultural function.
