



CUCSU polls in next 4 months

CHITTAGONG, Mar. 13.—The University of Chittagong expect to hold election to its Central Students Union (CUCSU) and hall unions within next three to four months. According to a Press release, the university will take time to hold long pending students union polls maximum up to July next.

This decision has taken at a joint meeting of Deans of different faculties, Provosts, Proctor, Professors, Chairmen of the departments, senior teachers and officers of the university. Vice Chancellor Prof. Alamgir Mohammed Sherajuddin presided over the meeting. Earlier the Vice Chancellor held a meeting with the Chhatra Sangram Parishad representatives to discuss about the forthcoming polls.

Meanwhile, the Islami Chhatra Shibir, in a immediate reaction to the announcement said that the unnecessary three to four months delay in holding the students union polls is nothing but a planned conspiracy to thwart the polls ultimately. The Shibir leaders in a Press conference on Friday afternoon claimed that the situation at Chittagong University now quite conducive to hold immediate polls.
