## Sangram Parishad students resume classes at CU

CHITTAGONG, Aug 19:
The Chittagong University
unit of Chhatra Sangram Parishad (CSP) yesterday agreed to
allow its supporters and others
to return to classes as the authorities pledged to consider
its demands by September 3.

The students of the University at the cell of the CSP, had been abstaining from classes since August 16 to protest violence on the campus and to press for several demands including ouster from the University of certain Chhatra Shibir workers whom the CSP blamed for recent clashes.

The suspension of the strike was announced after the Vice Chancellor of the university and the leaders of the parishad reached an agreement at Contd. on page 8 col., 3

talks yesterday. Parishad leaders, however, said the students
would begin to abstain from
classes from September 4 again
if their demands were not met
by the deadline.

Meanwhile, 237 students of the university in a joint statement yesterday demanded resignation of the VC for his alleged inability to restore peace and discipline on the campus.
