## CU students on rampage

CHITTAGONG, Mar. 10:—A group of students rampaged through Chittagong University campus today forcing a two-hour delay in the opening of the university's sports competition, reports UNB.

During the rampage the students exploded several fire crackers, burned three sports canopies and damaged furniture at the office of CUCSU.

There was no injury to anyone during the trouble that started as the authorities were preparing to open the sports meet. The identity of the trouble makers were not immediately known.

Campus sources said the sports meet was opened two hours behind the schedule because of the violence. Vice-Chancellor of the university Prof. A.M. Sirajuddin was the chief guest.

Rival student groups brought out processions protesting the incident. One procession was taken out by a combine of the 12 student organisations, which now control Chittagong University Students' Union.

Islami Chhatra Shibir, which lost the union in recent election, also brought out a procession and condemned the incident.

The 12-party combine in a press release demanded that the miscreants responsible for the attack be punished.
