The siege was withdrawn following assurance from the VC, Prof. Sirajuddin, that a committee would be set up to ensure law and order on the campus and that stern action would be taken against those responsible for terrorism irrespective of their party affiliations.

The VC, the Proctor and teachers were freed from the 17-hour ordeal.

Meanwhile, the combine, Islami Chhatra Shibir and Islami Chhatra. Sena brought out separate processions demanding free and fair elections on the campus.
