

No girls' school in three thanas of Sunamganj

SUNAMGANJ, Oct. 31:—Female education in Doarabazar, Shalla and Bishwanvapur thanas of the district has been hampering since long in the absence of any girls' school in these thanas, reports UNB.

District Education Office sources said there are 118 secondary schools in 10 thanas of the district of which only seven are girls' schools.

Local leaders and guardians time and again demanded of the authorities to set up girls schools in the three thanas but no step has yet been in this regard.

The rural people, mostly conservative and against co-education, do not permit their girl children to go to the distant girls schools in other thanas to prosecute their studies for fear of security.

As a result, a large number of intending girl students cannot prosecute their higher studies and are being dropped after their primary education.
