NARSINGDI: A total of 1,067 schools are being run by Grameen Bank in Dhaka Zone. In these schools 46,200 boys and girls of landless farmers are being imparted education. All expenditures of these schools are borne by the Bank. Besides, teachers of these schools are also given professional training by the Bank.

The Comilla District Primary

Education Officer told this Correspondent that 4,86,217 children out of 5,84,134 eligible for primary education in the Comilla district have been enrolled in the current academic session.

The teaching staff in the 1,328 Government primary schools of the district number 6,957 including 927 female teachers.

ACCOMMODATION PROBLEM

With the increase in number of students most of the government primary schools are facing acute accommodation problem. The classrooms and other facilities have also not been increased according to the demand. shortage of tables, chairs, benches, black-boards etc have added to the problem.

Besides these there are 206 non-government primary schools in the district with 37,290 students including 16,175 girls studying there. The teachers of these schools have often to pass their days in financial hardships as they do not get regular salaries.
