49.24 pc pass //Alim exams

A Sun Report

The results of the Alim, Fazil and Kamil examinations held during July-August were announced yesterday (Thursday).

A total of 29,026 students appeared, including 1,342 female candidates in the three groups of general Alim, science and Mjuabid-i-Mihir examinations.

A total of 14,293 students passed putting the total pass percentage at 49.24.

In the Alim examinations Shah Muhammad Moniruzzaman of Barguna Mokamia Alia Madrasha stood first. He secured five letters with a total of 837 marks and also scored the highest marks in the combined list.

Maksudur Rahman of Chittagong Sobhania Alia Madrasha secured the second position while ABM Zakir Hussain of greater Rangpur Karamatia Alia Madrasha along with Muhammad Mustafa Hussain of Karuna Mokamia Alia Madrasah jointly secured the third position.

In Fazil examinations the pass percentage is 53.52 with 7,561 students making the pass grade out of a total of 14,128 candidates including 287 female students.

Muhammad Anwarul Azm Majumdar of Comilla Islamia Alia Madrasha along with Abu Saleh Muhammad Fakruddin of Nishintipur Islamia Alia Madrasha jointly stood first.

In Kamil examinations a total of 5,709 students passed (73.12 percent) out of a total of 7,807 students including 36 female students.

Muhammad Abdur Rahman of Amirul Millat Madrasha of Dhaka stood first, Nizamuddin stood second while Muhammad Neyatullah secured the third place. 2
