BANBEIS to survey non-govt edn institutions

Bangladesh Bureau of Educational Information and Statistics (BAN-BEIS) has undertaken a programme to survey Non-government Educational Institutions throughout the country from May this year under supervision of an expert-committee formed by Ministry of Education, says BSS.

The survey aims at realistic planning through proper information management for improving the standard of education. Seven hundred twentyfive meritorious students who passed HSC examinations in 1991 and 1992 have been appointed as enumerator and 140 teachers of government colleges have been appointed as supervisors for the survey, an official handout said in Dhaka on Saturday.

the enumerators, supervisors and concerned officials have been requested to be present at Dhaka Alia Madrasha for participating in a special training on April 21 and April 22.

Meanwhile, letters have been issued by the Ministry to Heads of all Non-Government Educational Institutions with request to produce original certificates and photographs of the teachers and employees and necessary information and papers and photographs of the building of non-government schools, colleges and madrashas to the enumerators for taking preparation of the survey.

The enumerators and supervisors will undertake the survey at field level with necessary information forms from May 1 to 31.

All DCs, TNOs, District Education Offiction Officers Thana Education Officers and concerned officials have been requested to provide necessary cooperations in this regard. 02
